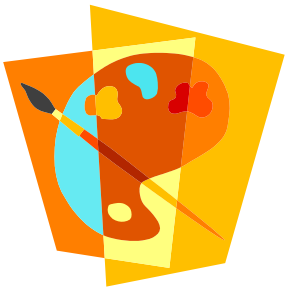

10.30am to 12:30pm.

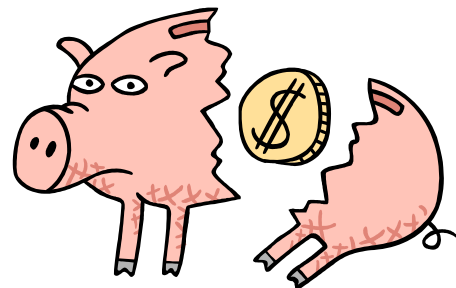
