I Have Asperger Syndrome

Asperger Syndrome (AS) is a form of autism. People with AS have difficulties with social understanding and social communication.

They have problems with...

- ◆ Becoming distressed if touched or restrained
- ◆ Eye contact, & may appear detached or uncommunicative
- ◆ Unpredictable behaviour
- ◆ Understanding sarcasm, jokes or irony
- ◆ Interpreting facial expressions and body language

People with AS will need the support of an appropriate adult.
